

CONCEP Staff Joins a Mixed-Income Housing Design Competition



The creative team of CONCEP recently joined a design competition on Mixed Income Housing Design called **Building Accessible and Livable Ecologies (BALÉ)** which is organized by **Bases Conversion and Development Authority (BCDA)** as part of the development of Clark Green City (CGC) – a new city envisioned to serve as an administrative and commercial center in Central Luzon. In anticipation of the development of CGC that will generate thousands of jobs, the need for mixed income housing units for the employees will arise.



The team adopted the name **Planning for Harmony and Integration (PHI)** that also represents their design and approach themed as **Armonía: Harmony in Diversity**.
